To promote accessibility, authors are encouraged to make submissions comprehensible to a broad audience. This includes providing explanations for technical terms and spelling out acronyms upon their first use.

All articles must be submitted no later than two weeks before the intended publication date, with a length ranging from two to six pages.

Editing for readability and length may be undertaken to better align articles with the needs of our diverse audience.

Format: Word (.doc)

Theme font: Times New Roman (including footnotes)

Font size: 12 for text and 10 for footnotes

Paper size: A4

Spacing: 1.15

Bold: Names of Conventions and International Treaties, of countries, of persons and, of Institutions

Quotes: Italic
